

IAPC Overview

Organized by AECOM in 1996, the International Audit Practice Consortium (IAPC®) is the industry-leading forum for sharing best practices and emerging issues in global environmental, health and safety (EHS) auditing and management for private-sector companies. Members include over 85 mostly global companies comprising the consortium in a wide range of industrial sectors, including agribusiness, biopharmaceutical, chemical, forest products/pulp & paper, manufacturing (other), mining, oil & gas/energy, pharmaceutical, technology, transportation, and others.

The mission of the IAPC is to promote excellence in global EHS auditing and management practices. In pursuit of this mission, the IAPC connects corporate EHS audit directors and managers to establish and/or maintain world-class audit programs by:

- Providing a forum for unparalleled networking and benchmarking among member companies, including the administration of periodic informal surveys on a wide range of topics requested by member companies
- Facilitating four meetings annually (two in North America and two in Europe)
 where member companies share best practices, lessons learned and emerging
 issues through presentations, facilitated discussions, and breakout groups

- Hosting numerous industry sector and region-specific roundtable webmeetings with focused discussion for member companies (see upcoming roundtable web-meeting dates on page 4)
- Surveying members biennially on their audit practices and presenting the findings in formal reports; an evergreen survey portal was established in 2024 for members to update at any time; the portal links directly to Power Bl dashboards; the IAPC's Twelfth Biennial Report on EHS Audit Practices was issued in March 2025
- Maintaining a members-only SharePoint site (the IAPC Resource Room)
 that serves as a repository of a vast collection of IAPC-related information,
 including meeting presentations, IAPC EHS audit program framework
 documents, benchmarking survey results, webinar recordings, roundtable
 series presentation materials and notes, information on EHS audit protocol
 updates from STP ComplianceEHS, AECOM's China and India EHS and CSR
 newsletters, and more

Evergreen Benchmarking

The IAPC initiated a new Evergreen Survey of EHS Audit Practices in August 2024. The Evergreen Survey covers sixteen major topics related to corporate-level EHS auditing practices. It is comprehensive by design and, although similar to previous IAPC biennial surveys, the Evergreen Survey is accessible for member companies at all times for updating and contains a more complete set of questions than past surveys.

The aggregated responses connect to Power BI dashboards (updated daily) that allow each member company to compare/benchmark its EHS audit practices to the aggregated responses of the other companies. The Power BI tool also allows members to filter the results by several categories.

The IAPC published its Twelfth Biennial Report on EHS Audit Practices in March 2025. The report includes AECOM's analysis of survey data along with insightful commentary and a look at attributes of leading EHS audit programs. The IAPC's biennial reports include unprecedented longitudinal data that document trends in audit practices among best-in-class global companies.


