Federal Lobbying Expenditures

In Calendar Year (CY) 2021, AECOM had aggregate federal lobbying expenditures of \$790,000, which were reported to Congress through our quarterly Lobbying Disclosure Act reports.

These expenditures include payments and overhead for internal lobbying staff (based on a percentage of their time lobbying in any given quarter), payments to outside lobbyists and lobbying firms, and the portion of dues paid to trade associations and coalitions used for federal lobbying purposes.

In addition to AECOM's internal registered federal lobbyists, as of March 31, 2022, AECOM retained four external lobbyists with anticipated payments to those firms totaling \$480,000 over the course of their annual contracts.
